



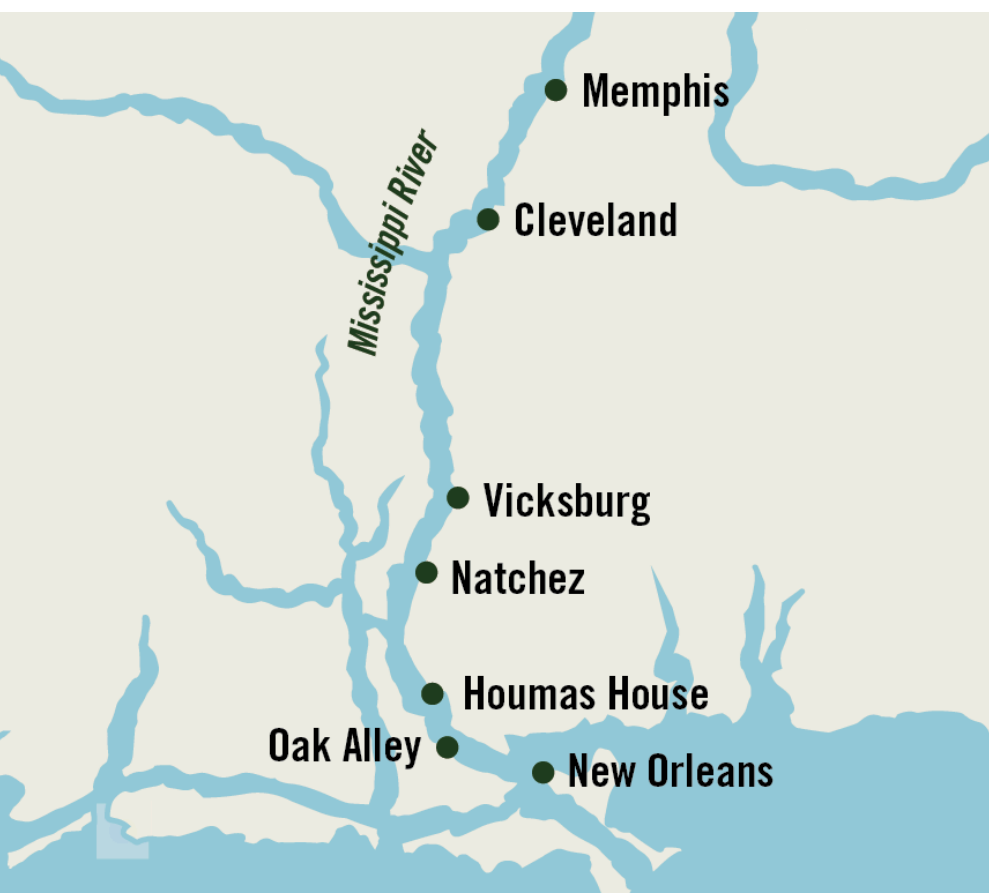

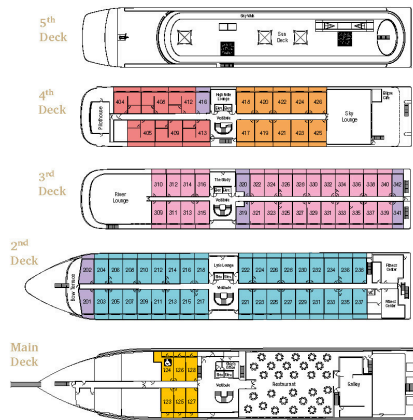
## American Riverboats | 180 Guests
