



Michigan State University Homecoming Parade Parade Rules for Elected Officials

*****No distribution of campaign literature is allowed.**

NOTE: Incumbents of the following political positions listed below may participate in the parade in election and non-election years. Only during an election year may those seeking office participate in the parade and only one candidate from each political party of the following positions will be allowed to register.

ONLY the positions listed below will be eligible to participate in the Homecoming Parade.

- President of the United States
- Governor of the State of Michigan
- U.S. Senator for State of Michigan
- Member of the U.S. House of Representatives (East Lansing)
- MI State Senator (East Lansing)
- MI State House Representative (East Lansing)
- City of East Lansing Mayor
- City of East Lansing City Council Member
- City of Lansing Mayor
- City of Lansing Council Member (Campus Jurisdiction)
- Township Elected Leader (Campus Jurisdiction)
- County Commissioners (Campus Jurisdiction)

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS

1. As an elected official/candidate, you must be the person participating in the MSU Homecoming Parade. You may not send a representative in your place.
2. The elected official/candidate can ride in a car or walk with a sign or banner.
3. You must provide your own car and driver and signage for your car. Only one car or vehicle is allowed per elected official/candidate.
4. Sign or banner dimensions: no larger than 20 feet long by 13 feet high (20'x13').
5. Please report to the Hannah Community Center by 5:30 p.m. Enter the Hannah Community Center parking lot via the Fern Street entrance off Abbot Road. Someone will greet you as you enter and assign you your spot in the staging area. Please park in that spot as soon as you arrive.
6. The parade will begin promptly at 6:00 p.m., so it is important that everyone is in their car and ready to go by 6:00 p.m.
7. Once you have been assigned a spot in the parade, it cannot be changed. There can be no exceptions to this rule.
